Sports Day and Picnic lunch

Weather permitting this will take place on Friday 23 June. For those of you who have not attended a sports day at Fetcham is runs like this:

Children will bring PE kits home and we ask that they come to school in them on sports day. Parents are invited to sit along one side of the running track (which will be marked by then) whilst the children sit in classes on the other side. At 9.45 am children will parade out in their classes, much like the Olympic Games. Once they are all out and seated the games will begin at 10.00 am! We start with flat races for all classes followed by novelty races. Once the whole school has completed all of their races the children will return to class for a cool down and an ice-lolly.

They will then come back out to sit with you and have lunch. A packed lunch including a filled roll will be supplied to all children. If you would like to stay please bring your own picnic and your child will be able to join you for a family picnic. We ask you to leave at 1pm when the children will return to the classroom for registration. Gates will be locked throughout the event. If you need to leave earlier than 1pm, you can exit through the office

or find a member of staff who will unlock the gate for you. At 1pm gates will be open for all parents to leave. Fetcham PTA will be selling refreshments.

Reminders:

Play equipment

This week I have talked to the children in assembly about the rules we have in school, which are in place to keep everyone safe. Unfortunately, the children are not following these rules before and after school so I would like your support to ensure that this happens and that we work together to give the children consistent messages.

During the school day,

- The children know that walking along the wall with the boxed seating is not allowed.
- The children know that climbing trees is not allowed.
- It is preferable if the children do not go on the play equipment in the morning as this often ends in tears because they do not want to leave it when the doors open. This is not a good start to their school day.
- The children also know there are rules for using this equipment including only one child at a time and only going in one direction.

• The children know that the bikes in the fenced off area are for year one use during the school day. Please discourage them of opening the gate before and after school.

School Office

The ladies in the office would be very grateful if you could make sure to include your child's class along with their name in any correspondence.

Uniform

Please remember that jewellery **must not** be worn in school with the exception of pierced earrings that must be removed at home on PE/Sports/Dance days.

If your child wears a hair band, please make sure it is small, plain and inconspicuous (no cats ears, bunny ears, stars, flowers or any other characters please).

Toys

Children are not to bring toys and other personal items into school. Much learning time is lost and there is often upset as we sort out ownership issues, look for lost items and try to repair breakages.

Watches

If your child is learning to tell the time, they may wear a small, inexpensive analogue watch. No large digital watches please.

Keeping everyone safe

Please may I remind you not to let your children ride cycles or scooters on the school site. There are cycle and scooter parks at both entrances.

Nuts

Please remember that we are a "nut and sesame free" school. Please **do not** bring nut/sesame or containing nut/sesame products into school.

Healthy School

We are very proud of our 'Healthy Schools' status which is why we do not encourage children to give out treats on birthdays. We do celebrate with your child, playing the singing birthday bear, singing happy birthday and giving out birthday stickers. The children love it and it makes them feel very special.
