The School Playground

School staff cannot supervise children on the playground before school. Parents are therefore asked not to allow their children to play on the apparatus prior to school. Please also do not allow your child to get out and use equipment.

Toys

Children should not bring toys and other personal items into school. Much learning time is lost and there is often upset as we sort out ownership issues, look for lost items and try to repair breakages.

Watches

If your child is learning to tell the time, they may wear a small, inexpensive analogue watch.

Please may I remind you not to let your children ride cycles or scooters on the school site. There are cycle and scooter parks at both entrances.
